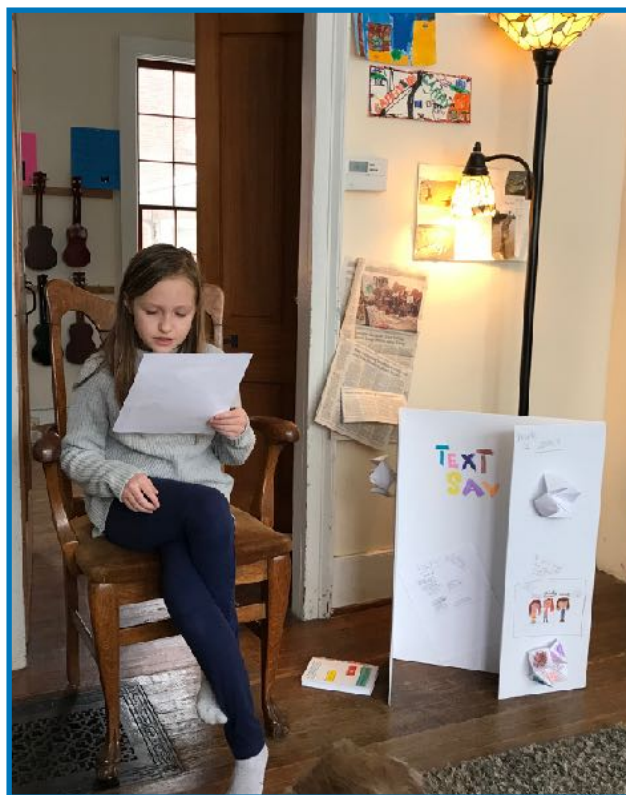

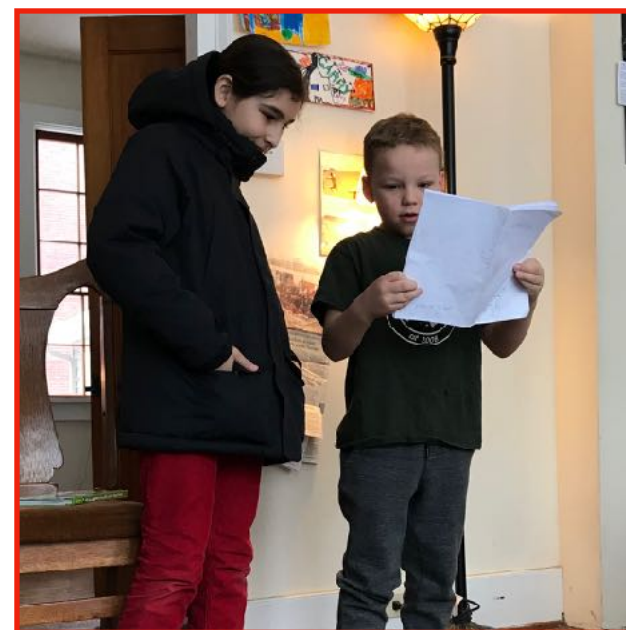

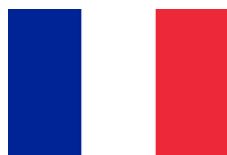


Mandala School Summer Camp: Back to the Basics
