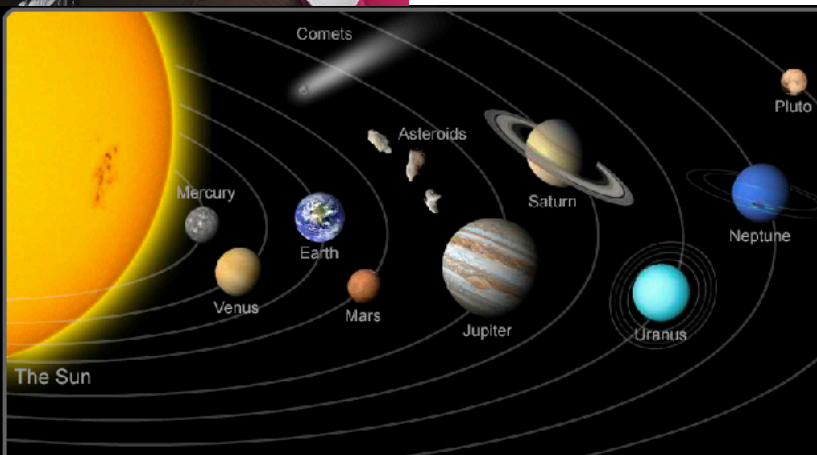
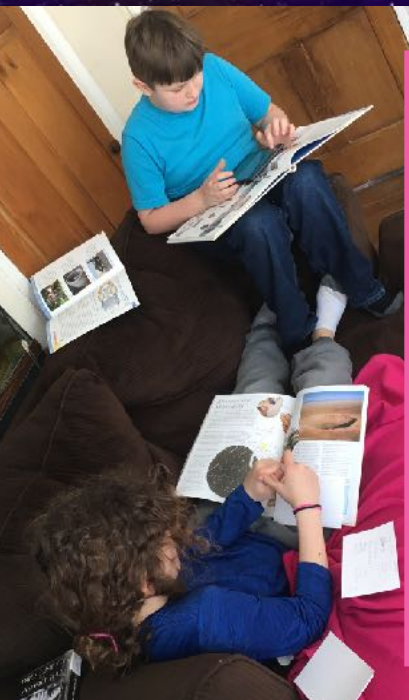

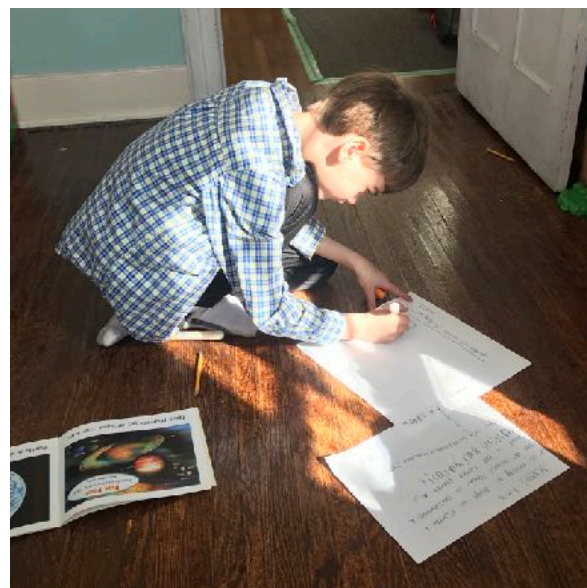

**activity:** playing video games

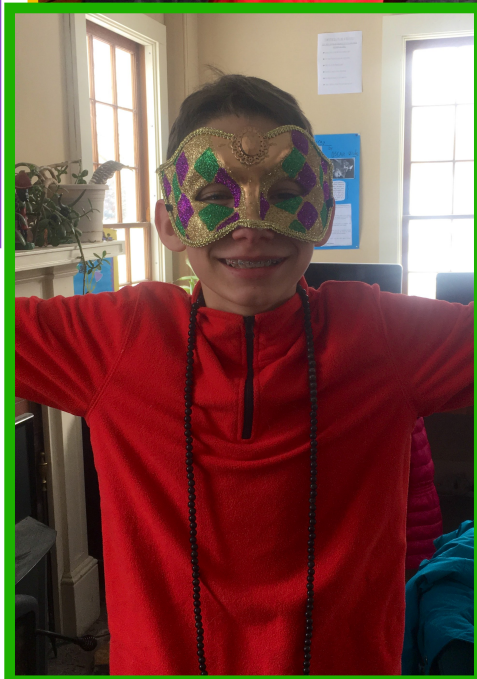
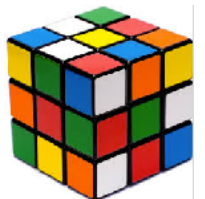
