I have been un-painting dining room windows at Mandala and un-paving a brick patio at home so both can be repaired. Also got the east side of Mandala painted.

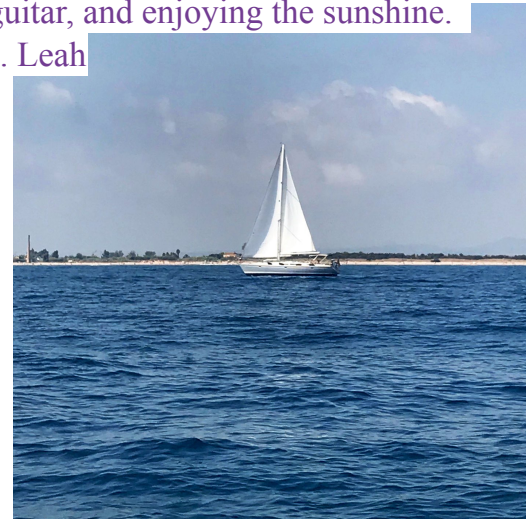
Non-chore time has been spent hiking in Northern California and the Adirondacks. A bit of time has been devoted to weaving.
