Thank you, parents for all your help! We hope everyone enjoyed their bread!



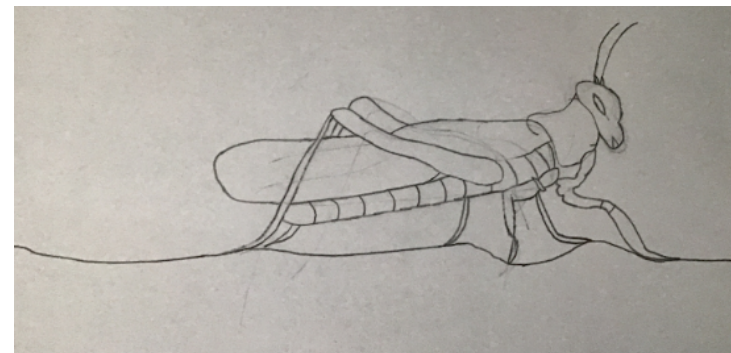
