




Earth Science By Katelyn

In Earth Science we have been working on the layers of the earth and Plate Tectonics. Alfred Wegener thought that the continents were all conjoined making Pangea at one point but didn't have any proof to explain how the continents moved. Pangea was during the Mesozoic era and started breaking apart 200 million years ago. After he passed away people discovered he was correct.

The main layers of the Earth are the Core, The Mantle, the Asthenosphere which is a part of the Mantle, and the Lithosphere. The two types of the Lithosphere are the Oceanic and Continental crust. Convections are when liquid gets hot and then will become less dense and rises, when it gets colder it will become more dense and will sink. Convection currents move the crust.
