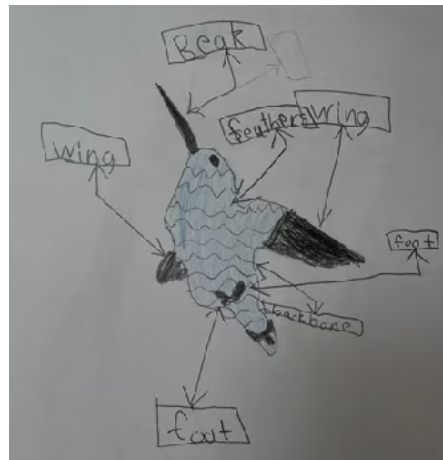
Above: Louie's toucan

Right: Amelia's hummingbird

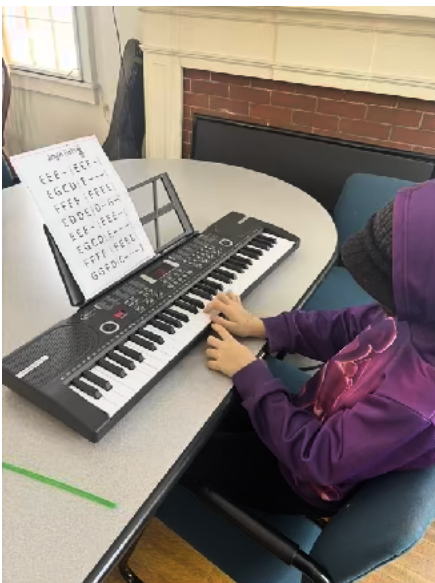
Top right: Winter's bald eagle
