They make me sing

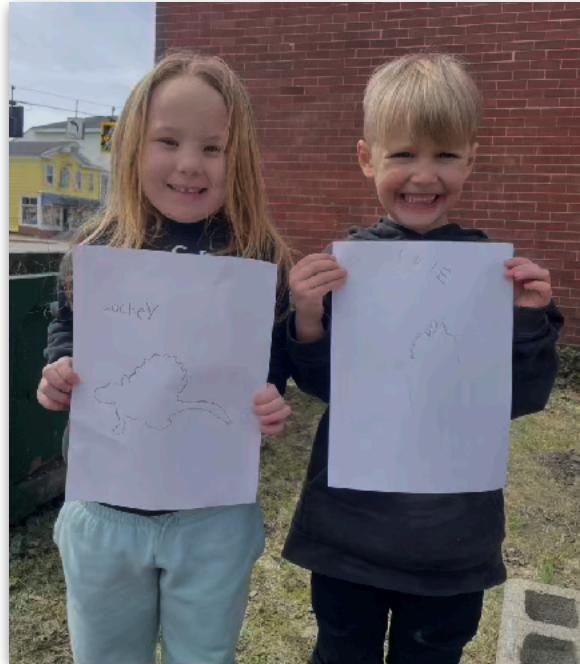
